### WHY IS JESUS CALLED THE ROCK of Ages



Mr. John buried a piece of rock and a very strong wood on 1<sup>st</sup> January 1978. Both items were subjected to rain, sunshine and heat. On 31<sup>st</sup> December 1978: that is after 12 months, Mr John dug up the soil to see what has happened to the wood and the rock. The wood

had rotten away and totally mixed up with the soil, but the rock still remained the same. Mr. John buried the rock again. He checked it every 31<sup>st</sup> December. Till date the rock is still the same, 40 years after!!!

Rocks are one of the most durable materials on earth, rocks are;

- Durable.
- Constant.
- Strong.

Does Jesus behave like this? Yes, even more!

Jesus has neither Beginning nor Ending. Just as explained, Rock is one of the most durable materials on earth, yet these rocks were made by Jesus. Jesus had been before the world was made. He made the world including the Rocks! The Bible says in 2Pt 3:10" But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heaven shall pass away with a great

noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up"

Jhn 1:3" All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made"

Col 1:14-16" In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins: who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: for by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible, whether they be thrones or dominion, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him"

# WATER FROM THE ROCK; NUM 20:1-11



The Israelites were still on their journey from Egypt to the Promised Land. They got to the desert called Zin. In a desert, nothing grows because all the land is either sandy or rocky.

Here Miriam; Moses senior sister died and as if that was not enough problem, their water got finished and there

was no sight of water nearby. Just imagine that, no water to drink, cook, and bath!! Am sure everywhere will smell.

Soon, a protest broke out against Moses and Aaron. "Give us water or send us back to Egypt! Why did you bring us here? Is Egypt not better? Please take us back! "The protest probably grew larger and larger. There was tension and Moses knew he could not produce the water, so he prayed to God who can do all things. We too should learn to do this too.

Did God do anything? Yes! He asked Moses to take his staff with Aaron to meet with the whole Israelites and speak to the Rock that water will come out for the people to use. However, by this time



Moses was angry with the people. Maybe because of the way they spoke rudely and angrily. In that rage, instead of speaking to the Rock he struck the rock: In spite of this water gushed out for the people.

Now, supposing, this water was not provided, what would have happened to them? They would have all died.

In the New Testament, after many, many years, Paul referring to this incident said, "that Rock was Jesus."

1 Cor10:4" And they all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ"

Did Jesus end His journey here with His people? No! Hear what the Bible says:

Matt 28: 20b" I am with you always, even unto the end of the world"

In the New Testament, He became flesh (man) here on earth and did many mighty works (miracles) by the power of the Holy Spirit. However His stay on earth as man was not for too long. His becoming a man was to die and shed His blood to remove our sin. Only blood can remove sin and Spirit does not have blood, therefore Jesus had to become a man to achieve this purpose. He focused on this assignment.

Heb 9:22"Andalmost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission"

One day He told His disciples that He will soon die but that He will rise from dead on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day. Some of the disciples probably pretended not to hear what Jesus was saying. May be a big joke! However Peter was bold enough to speak up; stop saying such nonsense" said Peter. True to His word, He died, was buried and rose from the dead on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day just as He said. Therefore you can trust His word written in the Bible.

He rose! His disciples and other people saw Him walk the streets again! But that was very

brief. Soon He went back to heaven. Till date and forever Jesus lives on!

More durable than the physical rock!! The physical rock will melt away at a time but Jesus the Rock lives forever

your daily decisions and action.







